Did you know that 1 in 4 women and 1 in 6 men experience Domestic Abuse at some point in their life?

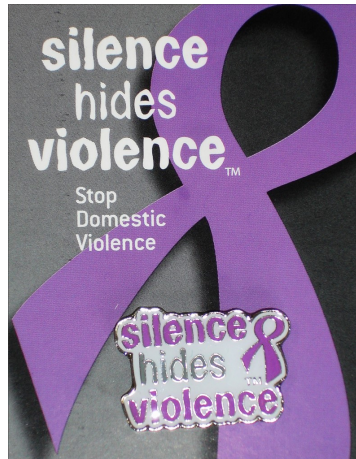
Did you know that Greater Manchester Police dealt with over 60,000 incidents of Domestic Abuse in the year leading up to November 2013
